



Performance Team Information

Drama Works Performance Team is an extension program for students that would like to further their studies, experience and participation in drama. This team is brought together to take part in the South East Queensland One Act Play Festival which runs from June to September each year. This is open to all Drama Works students aged 13 to 17 years. (*Opens Performance Team caters for those 18 years and older.*)

The entry process is by audition only. Successful auditions will then be given a place to take part in a wonderful theatrical experience, making new friendships and developing into fine performers with experiences they will never forget!

Performance Team students will have the chance to be nominated for a variety of dramatic awards as they tour and compete against other local youth theatre companies between July and August (*exact competition dates are released around June*).

Team Commitment

- Performance Team is considered an honour to be a part of and is in addition to regular weekly classes. Students must maintain their regular classes to participate.
- The commitment is a two-hour class each **Monday evening for terms 1, 2 and 3** of the year, from 6pm at Petrie Hall of Performing Arts.
- The program is \$297 per term (\$270 plus 10% GST). Fees include tuition, competition entries, props and rehearsal venue.
- An additional one-off fee of \$65 for the team shirt is required and ordered in term one.
- **Uniform** must be worn to class and when travelling – **Drama Works shirt; black bottoms** (*no short shorts or skirts*); **hair** must be tied back off the face at all times. In the absence of a uniform at the beginning of the year theatre blacks are to be worn.
- There will be a total of 3-4 weekends between **July and August** that every team member will be required. We consider all family needs when choosing which competitions to enter so that all students are available.
- Performance Team continues to meet when there is a Monday public holiday during the term.

Audition Details

Venue: Petrie Hall of Performing Arts, 1018 Anzac Avenue, Petrie

Audition Piece: A prepared monologue, of 2-3 minutes in length. Your character choice should express a number of emotions and movements that would best communicate your abilities. You should also consider the competency to use space, timing and voice effectively.
